L.A. County and City of Torrance to Offer Free Flu Shots to the South Bay Community

Torrance, Calif., October 24, 2007 – Just in time for flu season, the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health in partnership with the City of Torrance, will offer free flu shots to the public on Saturday, November 3, 2007 from 10:00 a.m. to 2 p.m. at the Charles H. Wilson Park Sports Complex, located at 2200 Crenshaw Boulevard. Free shuttle service will be available from the Torrance Federal Credit Union parking lot across the street from Wilson Park at 2377 Crenshaw Blvd # 150.

“You do not have to be in a high-risk group to get the flu shot,” says A.Nelson El Amin, MD, MPH, Medical Director of Los Angeles County Immunization Program, “Anyone 6 months of age and up who wants to avoid getting the flu or its complications and who does not have a medical condition against the flu vaccine, should get a flu shot.”
