COMMERCIAL ROBBERY

April 8, 2014 – 2ND RELEASE

DETAILS: On Wednesday, November 27, 2013 at 2:08p.m., the pictured suspect entered **YUM YUM DONUTS** at 17210 Prairie,



ordered a donut and when the lone female victim-employee approached the register, he grabbed her shirt, brandished a screwdriver and demanded the victim open the register and give him money or he would kill her. The suspect then jumped over the counter while holding on to victim's hair, grabbed the victim by the throat and lifted her off of the ground. He repeatedly



stabbed her with a screwdriver about her torso as she opened the register, then with his right hand, shoved the money from the cash drawer into his right pants pocket (bills only, left behind coins). The victim was then forced into the backroom where she was again stabbed multiple times, punched and had a glass bottle broken over her head.



SUSPECT DESCRIPTION: Black male adult,, late 30s-late 40s, 6'00' tall, thin build, dark complexion, narrow face, black hair, goatee, wearing a dark blue baseball cap, black sunglasses, an orange short sleeved button-up shirt, white undershirt, khaki pants, white sneakers (possibly Adidas), yellow metal watch on left wrist, yellow metal ring on left ring finger.



SUSPECT VEHICLE: None seen or heard; suspect was last seen heading N/B Prairie Ave on foot.
