### ATM SHOULDER SURFING CRIME TREND

**DETAILS:** The **TORRANCE POLICE DEPARTMENT** would like members of the public to know about an emerging crime trend at bank ATMs. Suspects will loiter in the area of ATMs and watch customers enter their PINs. The suspects will then use the victims' PINs to withdraw money from their accounts prior to the banking system locking out the victim-customers. This has been identified as a particular problem at **BANK OF AMERICA** sites due to the time delay in that bank's system closing out customers' transactions.

The following are things to keep in mind: the suspects are known to approach victims in an aggressive manner, sometimes shoving victims, causing many to prematurely depart the ATMs. The suspects are targeting victims who are shorter in stature so as to be able to look over their shoulders. ATM customers need to be aware of their surroundings while using ATMs and always lock out their transactions before walking away from ATMs.

The subjects pictured above were arrested following a police pursuit on Tuesday, December 15, 2015 after **BRYANT** was observed targeting customers at the **BANK OF AMERICA** at 21700 Hawthorne, Torrance.
