RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY

March 10, 2014

DETAILS: On Thursday, January 30, 2014, 10:30a.m., the victim heard an unknown subject knocking loudly on his front door and ringing the doorbell in the 4200 block of Sepulveda Blvd. The victim looked out the window and observed an unknown male standing in front of the door with his back to the door. Approximately one minute later, the victim heard a side gate open then observed the suspect kneeling on the ground outside of the living room glass double doors in his rear yard, holding what appeared to be a screwdriver in his hand and attempting to pry open the rear door. As the victim approached the door, the suspect looked at him, quickly stood up and began to run through the rear yard out of sight.

SUSPECT DESCRIPTION: Hispanic or Middle Eastern male, 17-20 years old, 5'11"-6'02" tall, slender build, lanky, black hair, brown eyes, hair short on the sides and spiked in the front, wearing a black and white plaid jacket, possibly hooded and faded blue jeans.
