MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in a special meeting in the Council Chamber, City Hall, Torrance, California, on Friday, October 23, 1936 at 4:30 P.M.

Mayor Stanger called the meeting to order.

Mayor Stanger stated that the members present constituted a full Council, a leave of absence having been granted Councilman Hitchcock.

Clerk Bartlett called the roll, those answering present being Councilmen: McGuire, Powell, Tolson and Stanger.

Clerk Bartlett read the call of the meeting, it being for the purpose of considering the City Auditor's report and taking proper action on same. He then read the report of C. J. Rambo and Company, City Auditors.

Councilman Tolson moved that the City Auditor's report be approved, that the recommendations contained therein be carried out, and that the City Treasurer be directed to deposit all City funds in his possession to the proper bank accounts on or before November 1, 1936. Councilman McGuire seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: McGuire, Powell, Tolson and Stanger. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

At 4:40 P.M., upon motion of Councilman McGuire, seconded by Councilman Powell, the meeting adjourned.
