

NORTH END RESIDENTIAL BURGLARIES APRIL 29, 2008



DETAILS: There were five single family residential burglaries reported between April 11-28, 2008 and they are plotted in the above map. The burglaries thus far have occurred on Mondays, Fridays and Saturdays most likely between 8:30a.m. and 1:30p.m. with the exception of the one Saturday attempt burglary that occurred at 7:45a.m. A common method of entry is the removal of the screen on a partially open window that is then opened wider by the suspect. Dowels used to prevent the further opening of a window are often compromised and this should not be considered a secure practice. The prying of rear windows and rear sliding glass doors is another frequently used method of entry. The suspects are targeting: guns, jewelry, currency, laptops, small electronics and T.V.s.

Residents are encouraged to be aware of the everyday as well as the unusual activity on their streets. Should anything seem peculiar or suspicious, do not hesitate to call the Torrance Police Department immediately rather than after the fact. Vehicles, people, behavior that do not seem to belong should always be reported immediately.
