## DOWNTOWN TORRANCE ASSOCIATION MEETING


Wednesday, October 4, 2017 – 7 p.m. at The Torrance Theatre Company 1316 Cabrillo Avenue




## DOWNTOWN TORRANCE ANTIQUE STREET FAIRE 19th Anniversary Show
