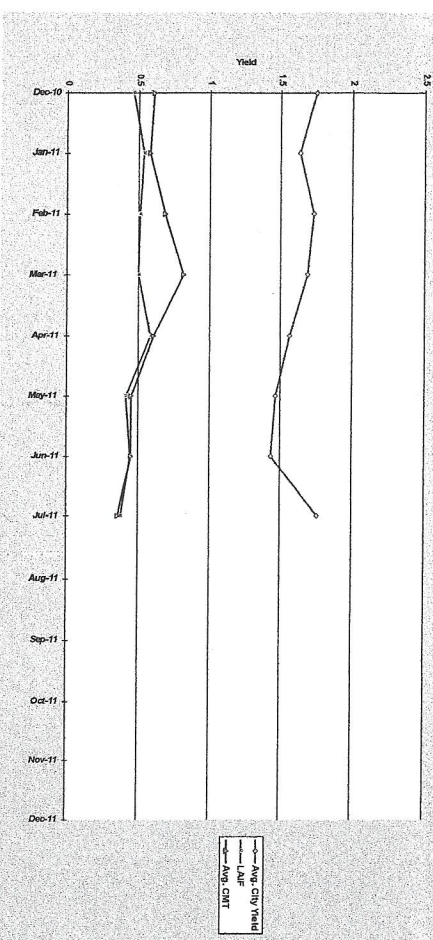

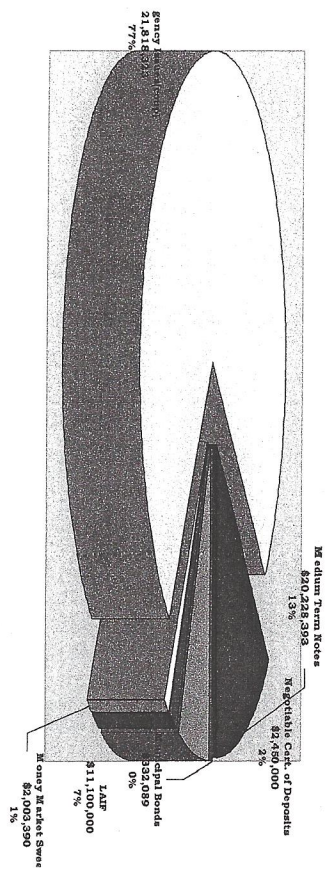

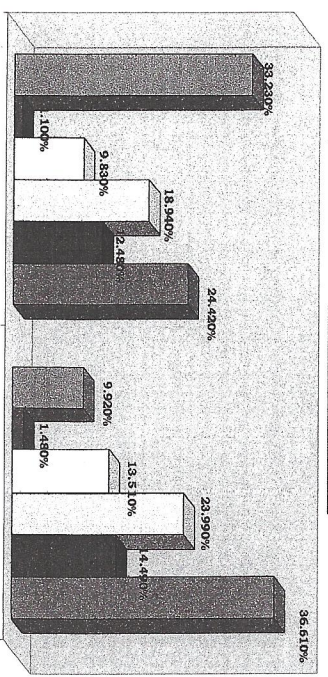
Portfolio Performance

Portfolio Maturity Distribution

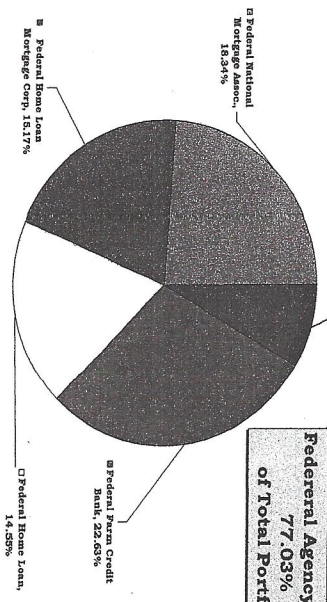


■ 1 day to 6 months

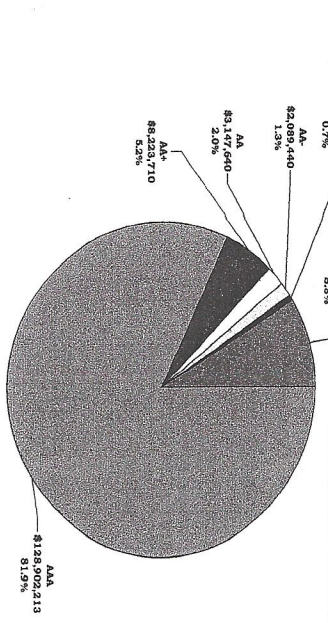

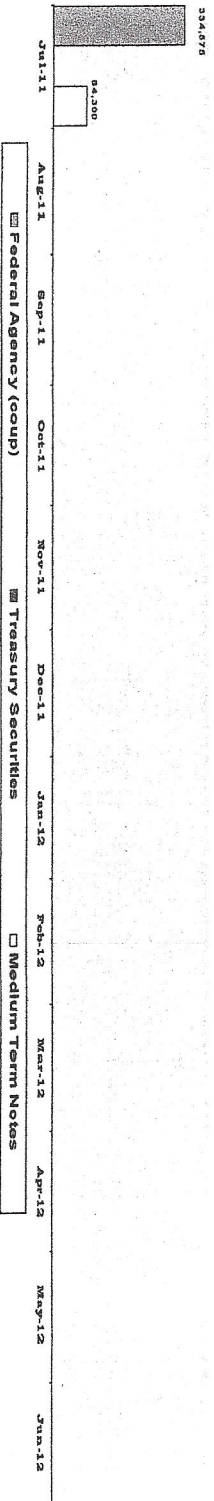

The Department Accounting Standards Board (GASB) has established Statement No. 31 for setting investment valuation standards. We will use the unrealized gain/loss monthly although we will not physically apply it to our books until year-end, as GASB 31 requires. The portfolio paper gain or loss is the difference between the book and market value of securities with a maturity term of one year or greater at purchase. The disclosure of paper losses reveals the worse case scenario of liquidity in our portfolio. The philosophy of the city is to buy and hold to maturity.

NOTE-381 passed in 1995, effective February 1, 1996, requires that local agencies submit a quarterly report to the legislative body containing detailed information on all securities, investments, and monies of the local agency. It also requires a statement of compliance of the portfolio with the statement of investment policy and a statement of the local agency's ability to meet the expenditure requirements of the pool for the next six months.



Portfolio Notes:
* Medium allowed by Investment Policy is \$50 million per agency. General LAIP account = \$ 3,500,000
* RDA LAIP account = \$ 6,600,000
* TRANS payment = \$17,000,000
* Note that this report accurately reflects all pooled investments and is in conformity with the city of Phoenix Investment Policy Statement adopted by resolution 2011-04 on January 4, 2011. A copy of this policy is available at the office of the City Clerk. The investment program herein shown provides sufficient cash flow liquidity to meet expenditures-estimated expenditures.
