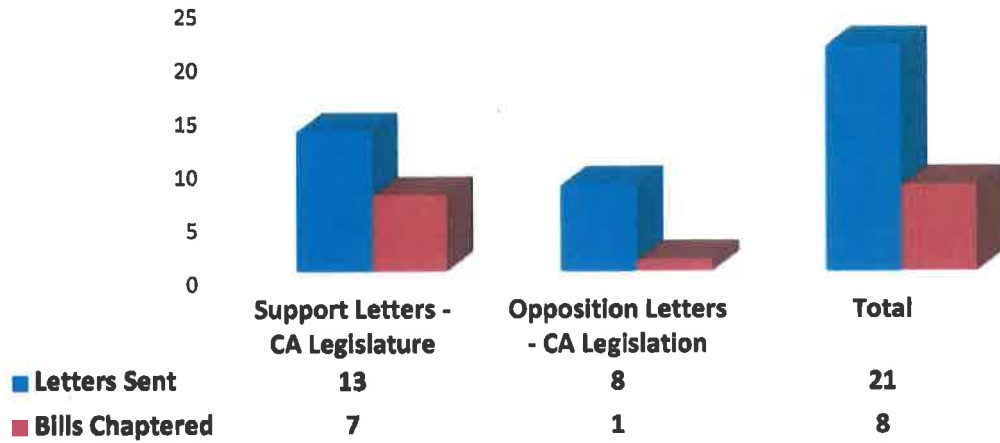

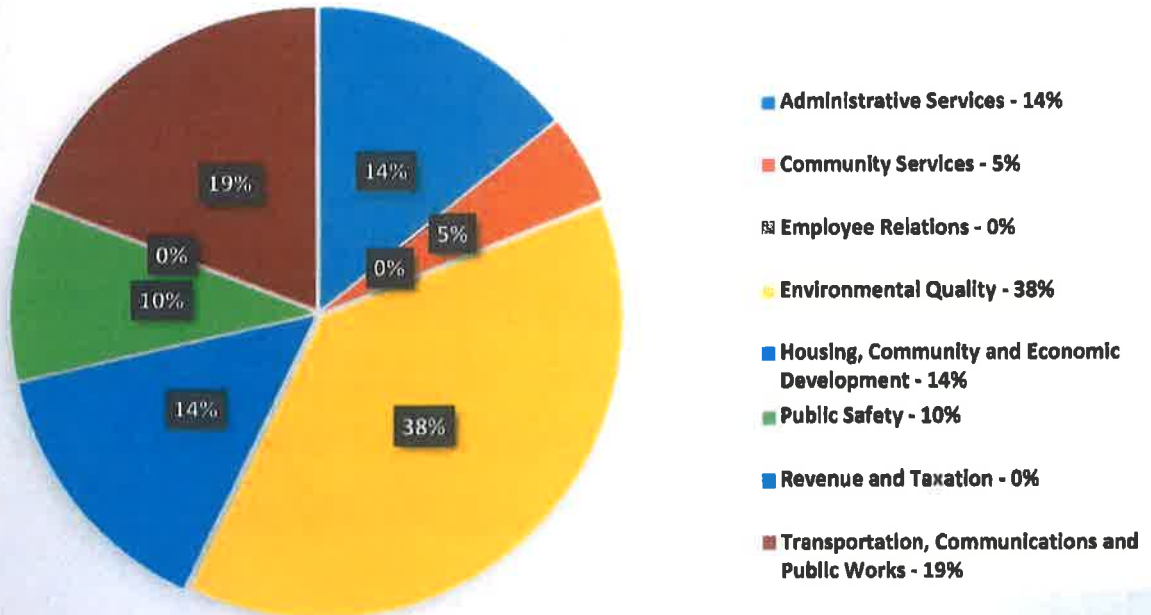
Outcome of All Letters Cycle 1: October 1, 2016 - September 30, 2017



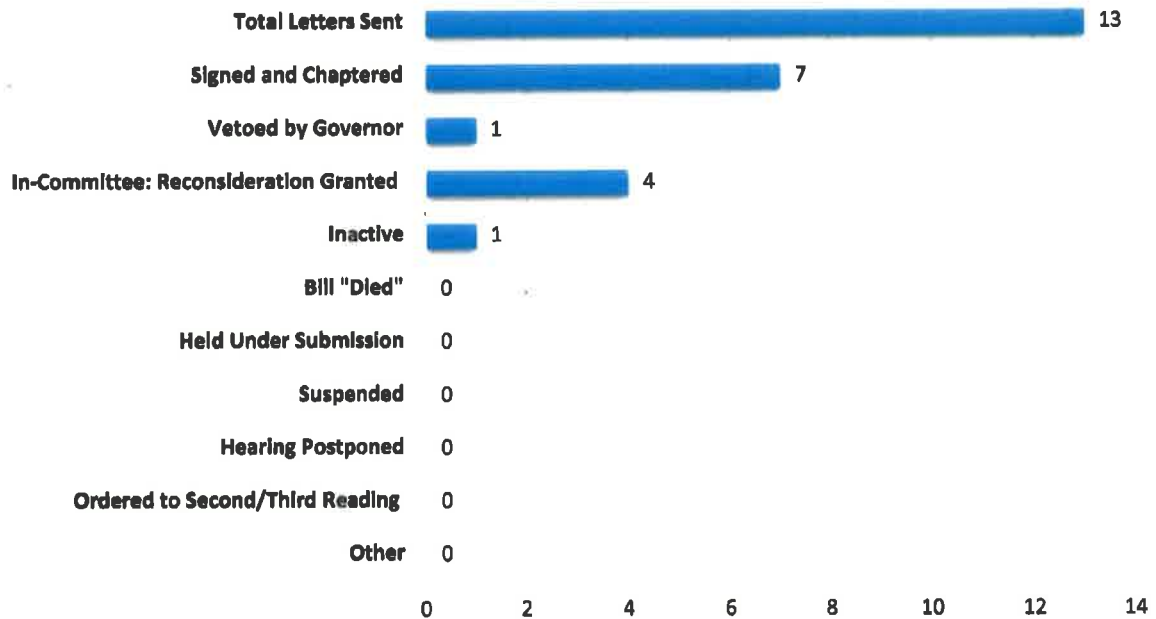
Percentage of New Legislation to Concur with City Position: 54%*

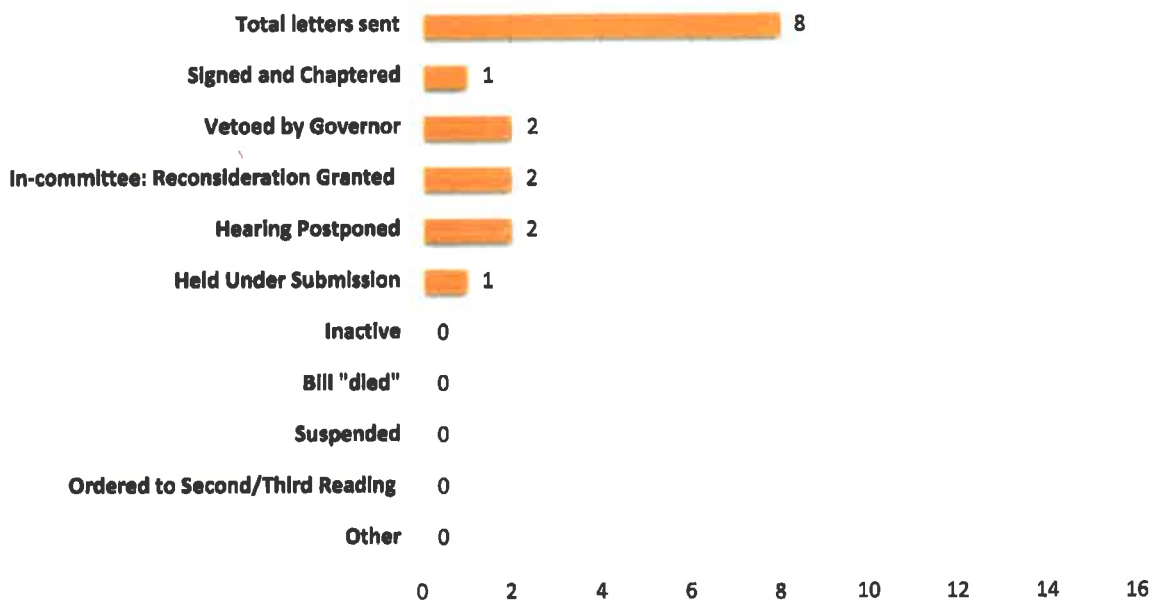
Policy Area of All Positions Cycle 1: October 1, 2016 - September 30, 2017
