On December 23, 2017, in the early morning hours, officers from the Torrance Police Department responded to a major traffic collision at the intersection of Anza Avenue and Lomita Blvd.

On arrival, officers discovered that a white 2013 Kawasaki motorcycle driven by a 21-year-old male, traveling westbound on Lomita Blvd. at Anza Avenue had collided with the west curbline, adjacent to Heroes Park. The 21-year-old male sustained major injuries and was treated by Torrance Fire Department personnel at the scene and he, unfortunately, succumbed to his injuries.

The southbound lanes of traffic on Anza Avenue between 226th Street and Lomita were closed for approximately six and a half hours during the investigation.

This collision is being investigated by the Torrance Police Department's Traffic Division under the command of Captain Martin Vukotic, Commander of the Special Operations Bureau.
