Rock Around the Block

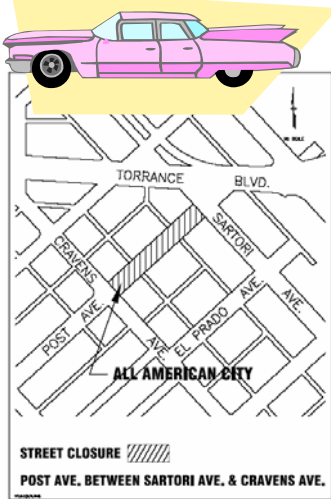

On **Thursday, July 19, 2007**, between 5 p.m. and 8 p.m., the 3rd Annual 50's themed summer street party will be held on Post Avenue between Sartori and Cravens Avenues (see map below). **Post Avenue will be closed to through traffic, between 3:30 p.m. and 9:30 p.m.**, only emergency vehicles will be allowed access. Traffic will be detoured and rerouted around the Historic Downtown Torrance streets and Downtown access will be made available via Cravens and Sartori Avenues; alleys will also be blocked for safety. Police officers and detour signs will be placed throughout the area, to assist motorists around the street closures.

In partnership with Toyota and the City of Torrance, the Torrance Historical Society will be hosting this family and neighborhood event in front of the Museum, located at 1345 Post Avenue, which includes music, contests and food from the '50's with classic cars displayed in the parking stalls on Post Avenue – all in celebration of the "All-America City Award" received in the mid 1950's.

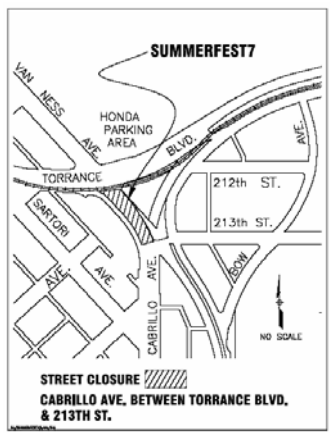
SummerFest 2007
