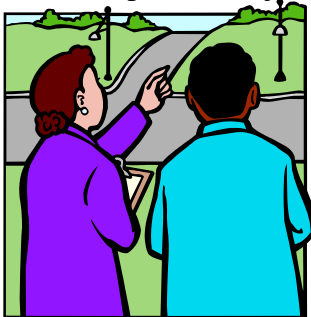


City of Torrance Redevelopment Agency Downtown Bulletin

During the week of **July 30, 2007**, DigAlert will notify various utility companies to mark and identify underground utility lines on the street and sidewalks along **Cravens Avenue, between Torrance Boulevard and Carson Street** (see map). This work will assist the City of Torrance Redevelopment Agency Staff in conducting continuing improvements in the Downtown Redevelopment Project Area. This work will be



performed quickly and no impacts are expected on the street or sidewalks of Cravens Avenue. For more information, contact the City of Torrance Redevelopment Agency Staff at

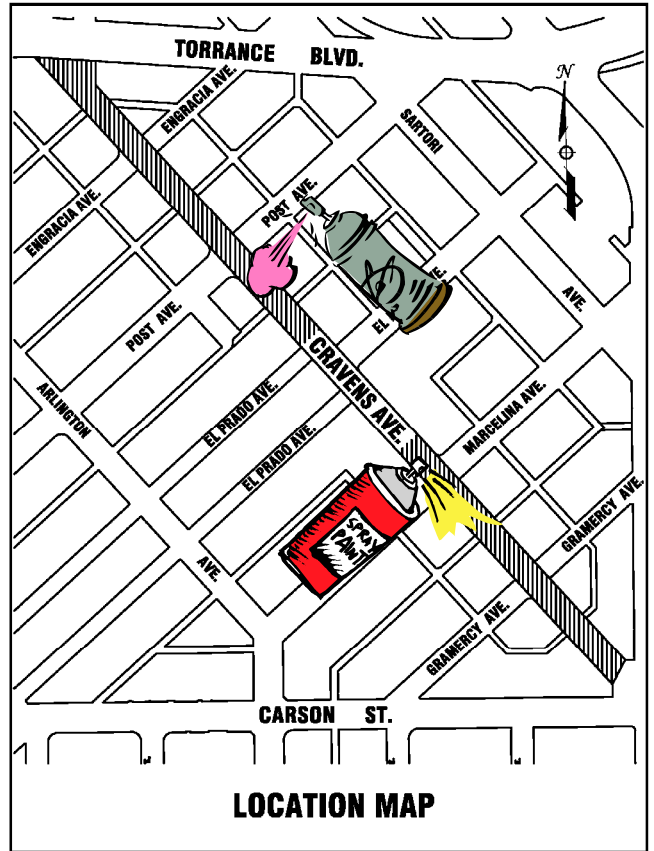
