13th Annual Halloween Ball and Benefit

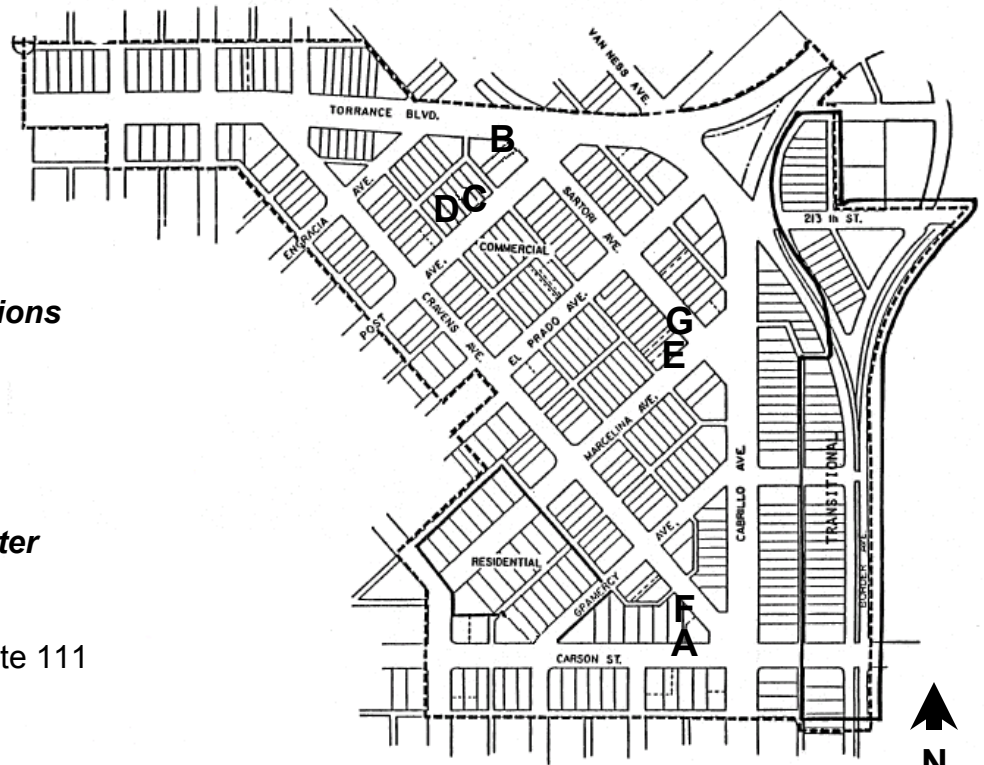
