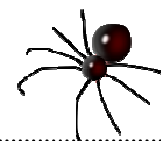


## The “Almost Great Pumpkin Street Fair”

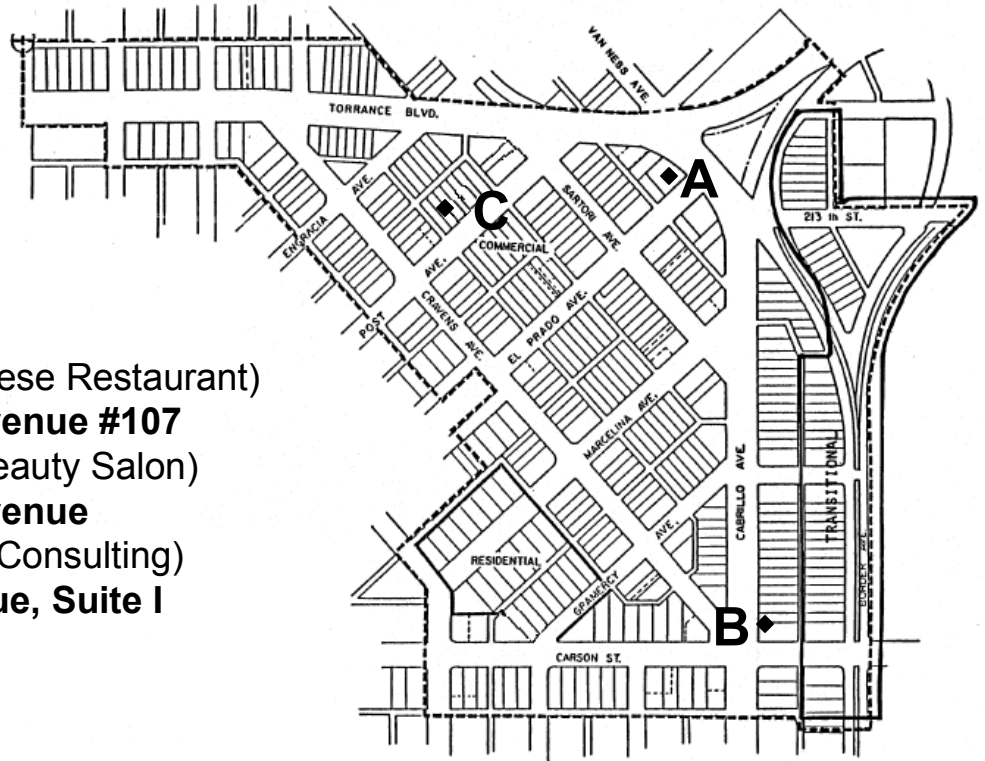
