

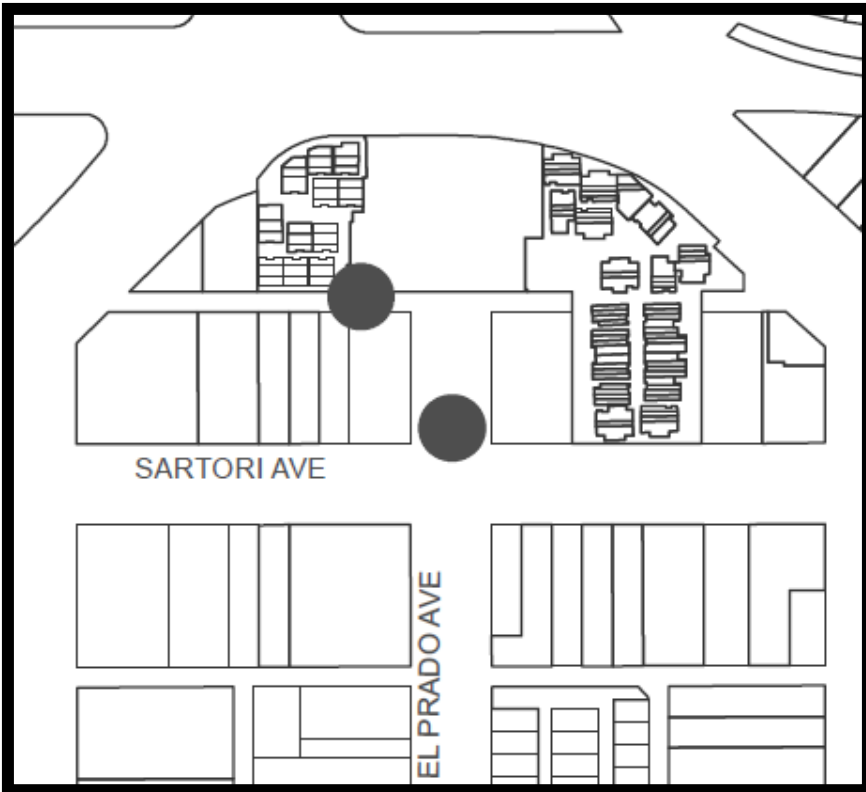

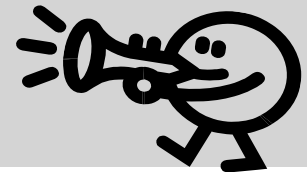
New Bollard-Well Installation in Public Right of Way



Due to the increasing number of community events being held Downtown, the City of Torrance Public Works Department will be installing six new wells for removable bollards (four on El Prado Avenue just east of Sartori Avenue, and two in the alley east of Sartori Avenue) to help improve public safety during these events. The work will result in temporary spot closures at these locations (see map, left) between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. from June 23-25th. Thank you!

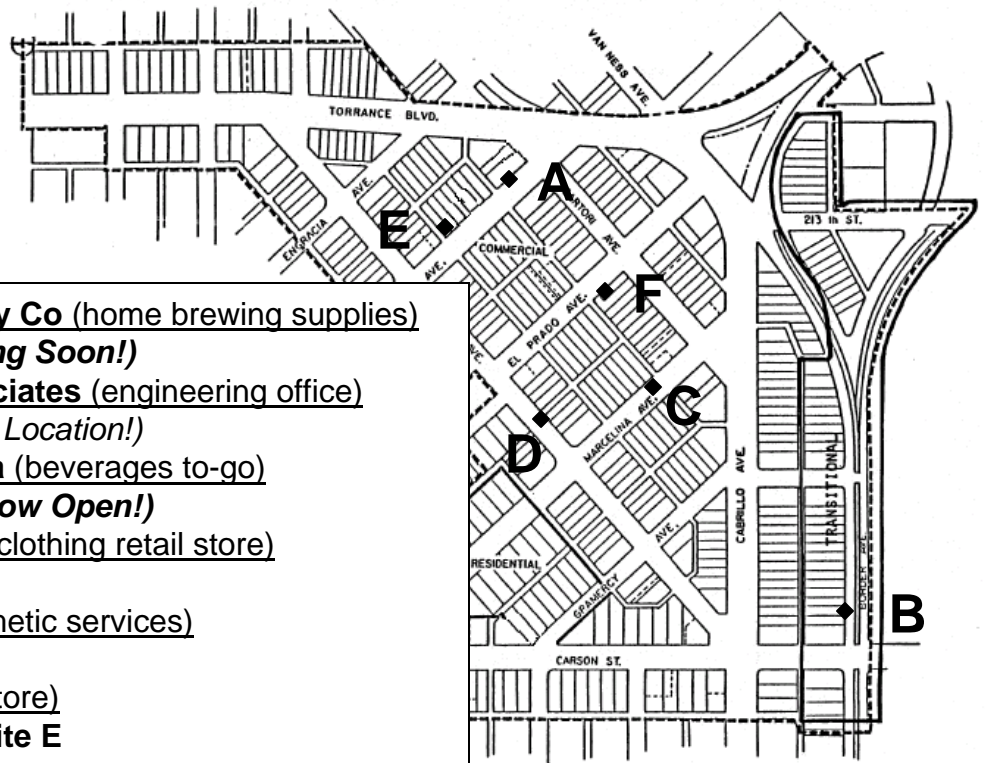

Time: 5:00 P.M. – 8:00 P.M.



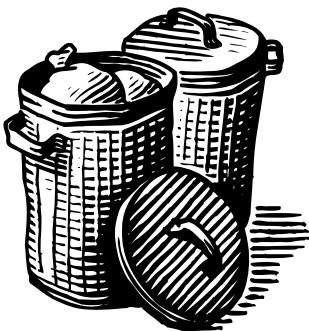
