



#### **Overhead Lighting Along El Prado Avenue**

October 27, 2010



In an effort to help revitalize the Downtown area, the City will be installing decorative LED overhead lighting along El Prado Avenue from the Plaza del Prado to Cravens Avenue (see map). The energy efficient lights will be strung along the palm trees and turned on during evenings to help improve the pedestrian atmosphere at night, while still maintaining the City's commitment to sustainable energy. The installation will occur after hours to avoid disrupting regular business operations. Lights are expected to be in operation by mid-December 2010.















# Welcome to the Downtown Redevelopment Project Area
