ACCESSIBLE PARKING SPACES

A message from Torrance Public Works


In an effort to make the Downtown Torrance area more accessible, the City will soon be converting 15 existing angled parking spaces in the downtown area to being designated as parking for those with disabilities. Each converted space will be marked with blue paint and include a sign and adjacent loading/unloading aisle. The spaces may be used only by vehicles that display the required placard issued by a Department of Motor Vehicles. The location for each space was determined primarily on providing the most convenient and beneficial access to all.

Schedule: Work will begin shortly after July 4th and be completed by the end of July.

Parking impacts: Parking in each affected space will be prohibited for approximately 2 hours while we complete the work.
