## RECOMMENDATION

Recommendation that the Oversight Board accept and file the attached report on the payments made to the Affected Taxing Entities from the Low and Moderate Income Housing Fund as a result of the Oversight Board's actions related to AB 1484.

## **BACKGROUND AND ANALYSIS**

Following the adoption of redevelopment dissolution bill ABx1-26, the funds that formerly would have been distributed to a redevelopment agency as tax increment are now used to pay obligations listed on the Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule (ROPS) while any remaining balance of funds are distributed to local agencies. In 2012, Your Honorable Body: reviewed and approved 3 ROPS covering January 1 through June 30, 2012, July 1 through December 31, 2012 and January 1 through June 30, 2013; reviewed and approved two Due Diligence Review (DDR) Reports; reviewed the 5-year cash flow projection; and approved the transfer of former Redevelopment owned property to the City of Torrance. In addition to the overall wind-down of redevelopment activities, the result of the actions taken by Your Honorable Body is the disbursal of approximately \$4.8 million in funds to local agencies such as schools and community colleges, the County of Los Angeles and the City of Torrance.

Staff recommends that the Oversight Board accept and file the attached report on the payments made to the local Affected Taxing Entities as a result of the Oversight Board's actions in 2012.
