Major Traffic Collision

On Saturday, May 11, 2019, at approximately 1:47 AM, Torrance Police Officers responded to the area of Pacific Coast Highway and Calle Mayor regarding a major traffic collision involving a vehicle and a pedestrian.

The preliminary investigation reveals the driver of a 2017 Ford Fusion was travelling westbound Pacific Coast Highway at Calle Mayor on a green light when a pedestrian, outside of the crosswalk, crossed in front of the vehicle.

The pedestrian, a 34-year-old male resident of Torrance, was treated by Torrance Fire Department personnel at the scene, and later transported to a local hospital with major injuries.

The driver of the Ford Fusion, a 58-year-old female resident of Redondo Beach, was not injured. Alcohol or drugs do not appear to be a factor regarding the driver.

Westbound lanes of Pacific Coast Highway and southbound lanes of Calle Mayor were closed until 5:00 AM during this investigation.
