Reserve Fire Inspector:

- Assist with Fire and Life Safety inspections
- Provide Public assistance
- Provide Administrative support
- Assist with Public Education events

After successful completion of this one year volunteer Internship Program, participants will be equipped:

- With valuable skills for entry level inspectors position
- Basic to advanced skill set to conduct fire and life safety inspections
- Exposure to Public Servant ship
- Understanding and experience in the operation of various life safety systems.

What is the Schedule?

Participants in this volunteer program will be expected to commit to volunteer (unpaid) one year of service.

How do I qualify for the Internship Program?

- 18 years of age, High School Diploma or GED
- Current enrollment or completion of course work in fire science, fire technology or related work.
- Successful completion of Fire Prevention 1A and 1B
- Valid California Driver's license, in good standing
- Ability to work independently
- Ability to adhere to the uniform and grooming standards of the Torrance Fire Department.
- Ability to volunteer one 6/8 hour day per week for a one year commitment.
