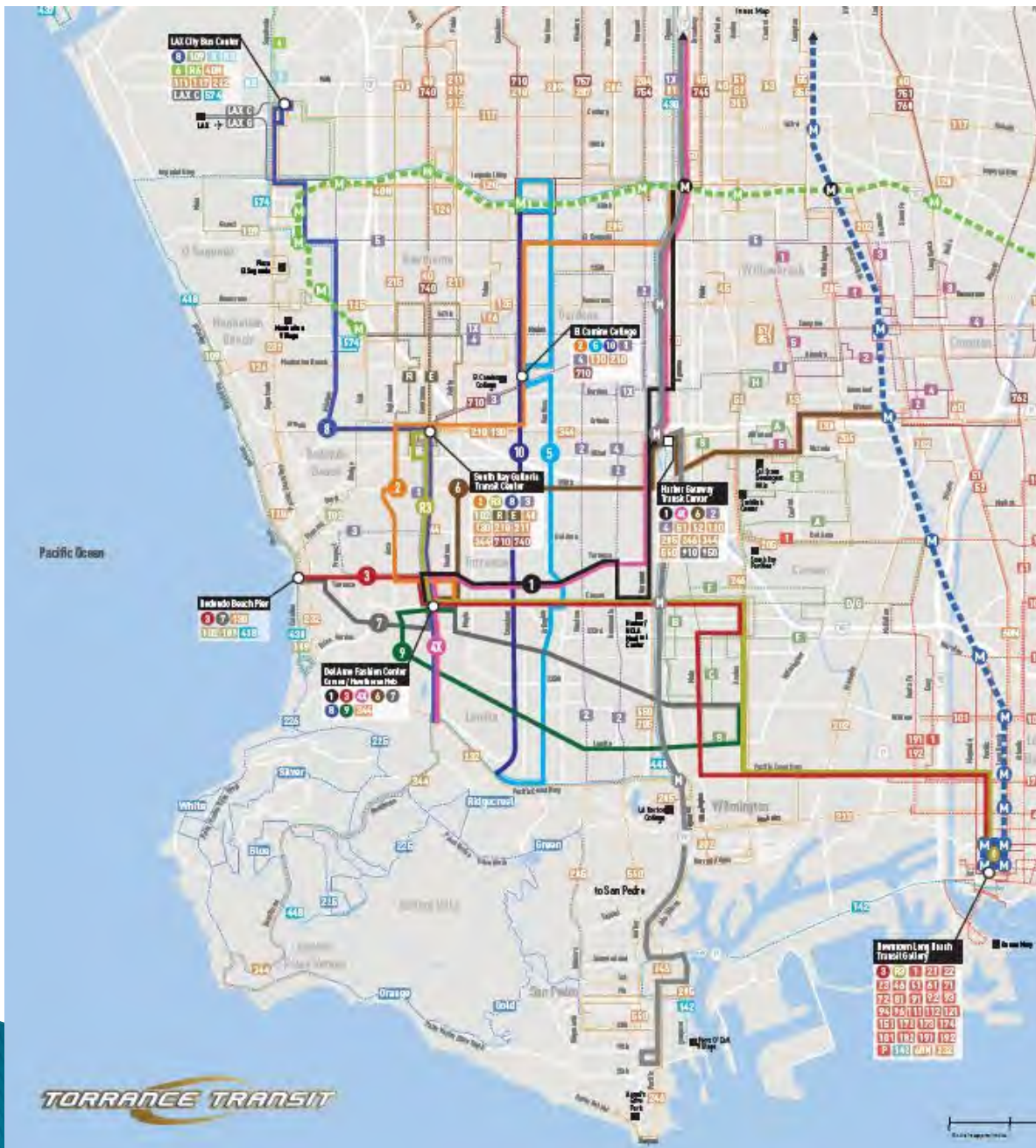
Over 79 Years of Dedicated Service...

History of Torrance Transit

- ▶ Established in January of 1940
- ▶ Fixed Route Service
 - 11 Lines (including 1 Express and 1 Rapid)
 - 800 Bus Stops Systemwide
- ▶ Torrance Community Transit Program
- ▶ Service Area: Torrance, Carson, Gardena, Downtown Los Angeles, Hawthorne, Redondo Beach, El Segundo and Harbor City.
- ▶ Ridership: 4 Million (Annual Avg.)
- ▶ Fleet:
 - 63 Buses – 53 CNG & 10 GE
 - Electric Buses in late 2020

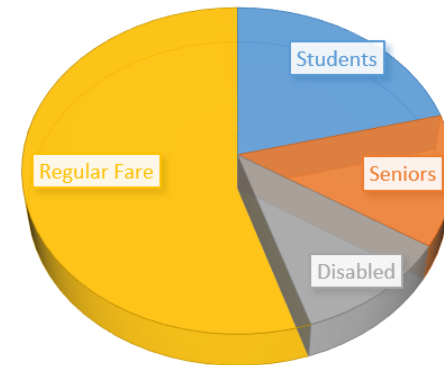

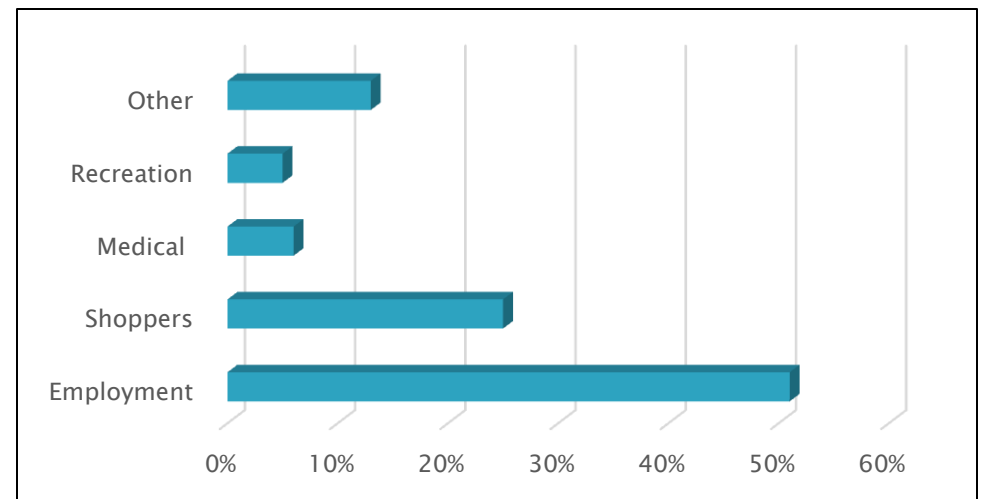


Activity

- ▶ 79 Years of Continuous Operating Experience
- ▶ 13K Average Weekday Boardings
- ▶ Over half of the ridership are low-income individuals or from a minority population
- ▶ Seamless connectivity throughout the South Bay, along with regional and local connections to other Transit providers and rail service
- ▶ Promotes Multi-Modal Travel (i.e. – Bicycle, Rail, etc.)
- ▶ Reduction of Greenhouse Gas Emissions, Fuel Consumption and Congestion on Local Roads
- ▶ Supports local economy in terms of job creation and sustainability


