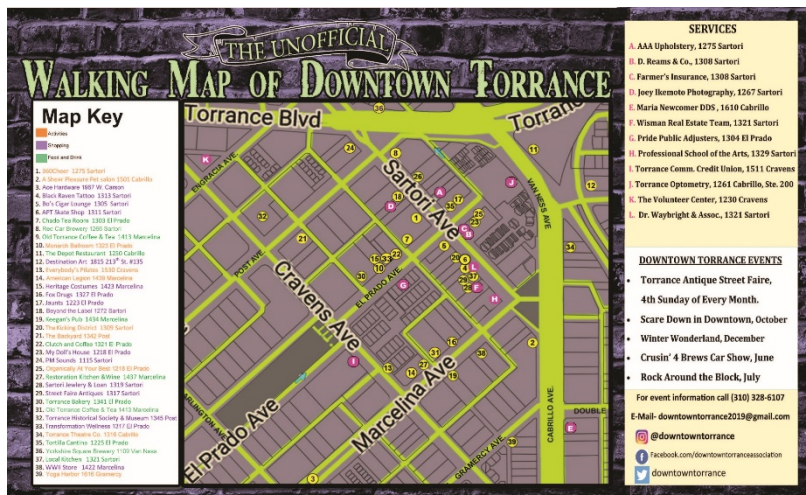

CRA VENS A VENUE CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Construction will resume on Cravens on Monday, October 28th. That week, saw cutting of concrete will be performed in preparation for concrete removal, which will start the following week. Attached is the construction notification that was distributed yesterday to businesses and residents along Cravens.

On the week of November 4th, concrete removal will be done on the sidewalk, curb, and gutter on both sides of Cravens between Carson and Gramercy. This road segment will be completely closed to vehicle and pedestrian traffic for this portion of the work. Concrete will be poured back within five working days after removal.
