PLANNED DUI CHECKPOINT

On **Friday, December 13, 2019** between 8:00 PM and 3:00 AM the following morning, the Torrance Police Department Traffic Division will conduct a DUI/Drivers License checkpoint at an undisclosed location. The checkpoint will be funded by a grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety, through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration. Our Police Department offers these reminders to ensure a fun night doesn't get spoiled with a DUI:



- ✓ Always use a designated sober driver a friend who is not drinking, rideshare, cab or public transportation – to get home.
- ✓ See someone who is clearly impaired try and drive? Take the keys and help them make other arrangements to find a sober way home.
- ✓ Report drunk drivers Call 911.
- ✓ Hosting a party? Offer nonalcoholic drinks. Monitor who are drinking and how they are getting home.

Getting home safely is cheap, but getting a DUI is not! Drivers caught driving impaired and charged with DUI can expect the impact of a DUI arrest to be upwards of \$13,500. This includes fines, fees, DUI classes, license suspension and possible jail time. The Torrance Police Department continues to encourage the community to be vigilant and report Drunk Drivers.
