

Major Traffic Collision



The preliminary investigation reveals the driver of a silver 2007 Nissan Murano was traveling northbound Crenshaw Boulevard. Upon approaching the intersection, the Nissan Murano rear-ended a 2014 Lexus causing the Nissan to veer into opposing traffic. While veering into opposing traffic, the Nissan collided with five additional vehicles.

The driver of the Nissan, a 37-year-old male resident of Torrance, was treated by Torrance Fire Department personnel at the scene and later transported to a local hospital with major injuries. A 19-year-old male resident of Torrance was also transported to a local hospital with major injuries. Two additional individuals were treated on scene and transported to a local hospital with minor injuries. Alcohol or drugs do not appear to be a factor in the collision.

Northbound and Southbound lanes of Crenshaw were temporarily closed for approximately 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ hours during the investigation.
