

On Wednesday, February 26, 2020, at approximately 8:01 PM, Torrance Police Officers responded to the 24200 block of Crenshaw Boulevard regarding a traffic collision involving a vehicle and a pedestrian.

The preliminary investigation reveals the driver of a 2000 Jeep Grand Cherokee was traveling north on Crenshaw Boulevard. While traveling north on Crenshaw Boulevard, the Jeep Cherokee struck a pedestrian walking east across Crenshaw Boulevard.

The unidentified pedestrian was treated by Torrance Fire Department personnel but unfortunately succumbed to his injuries at the scene. The driver of the Jeep, a 55-year-old male resident of Torrance, was not injured.

Alcohol or drugs do not appear to be a factor in this collision.

All lanes of Crenshaw Boulevard between Torrance Crossroads and Skypark Drive will be temporarily closed during this investigation.
