## *Evening Arrests*

During overnight hours between Sunday, May 31, 2020, at 6:00 PM, and Monday, June 1, 2020, at 6:00 AM, the Torrance Police Department made 24 arrests. The arrests included seventeen adults and seven juveniles. The arrestees were charged with a variety of theft-related crimes, including burglary, possession of stolen property, grand theft auto, and curfew violations.

The City of Torrance will once again be under curfew tonight at 6 p.m. - 6 a.m. to be consistent with the Countywide Order issued by the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors. The curfew will be in effect every day during the state of local emergency.

The Torrance Police Department will continue to take preventative measures to protect the community by deploying extra staffing throughout the City during the declared local emergency. Any person not abiding by this declaration is guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to punishment in accordance with Torrance Municipal Code section 16.2.13 or Government Code section 8665.
