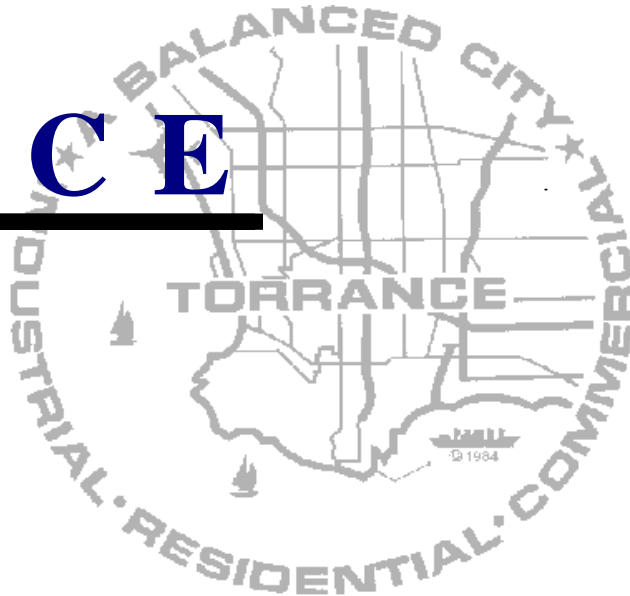

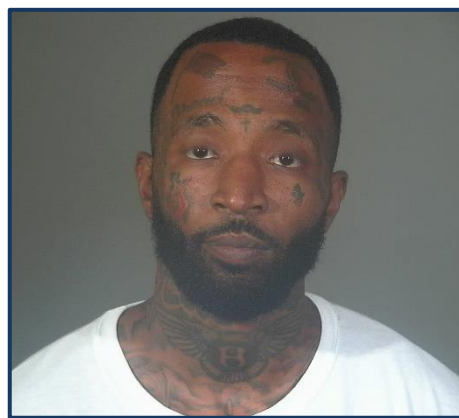

### Pharmacy Burglar Arrested

On July 02, 2020, Torrance Police officers responded to 3400 Lomita boulevard when the pharmacy owner discovered that unknown suspect(s) had burglarized his business and removed prescription medication. During the investigation, Torrance Police Detectives learned that the suspect(s) had possibly committed additional burglaries throughout Los Angeles County. Detectives conducted surveillance and collaborated with the other agencies to identify a possible suspect.

On August 19, 2020 Detectives arrested, 35-year-old Brandon Williams of Los Angeles for commercial burglary. Williams is believed to be responsible for burglaries in Pasadena, Monterey Park, Culver City, and Torrance. The case was later presented and filed with the Los Angeles District Attorney's office.
