

On Tuesday, February 23, 2021, at approximately 9:14 PM, Torrance Police Officers responded to the intersection of Artesia Boulevard and Hawthorne Boulevard regarding a traffic collision involving a vehicle and a pedestrian.

The preliminary investigation reveals the driver of a 2011 Honda CRV was traveling north on Hawthorne Boulevard. While traveling north on Hawthorne Boulevard, the Honda CRV struck a pedestrian at the intersection of Artesia Boulevard and Hawthorne Boulevard. Investigators will conduct an extensive investigation to determine the details of this incident.

The pedestrian, a 57-year-old male, was treated by Torrance Fire Department personnel but unfortunately succumbed to his injuries at the scene. The identity of the pedestrian is being withheld pending notification to a next of kin.

The driver of the Honda was not injured, and alcohol or drugs do not appear to be a factor in this collision.

Eastbound, Westbound, and Northbound lanes of Artesia Boulevard and Hawthorne Boulevard were temporarily closed for approximately 4 hours.
