## Major Traffic Collision

On Tuesday, June 15, 2021, at approximately 9:32 AM, Torrance Police Officers responded to the intersection of Torrance Boulevard and Amie Avenue regarding a traffic collision involving a vehicle and a pedestrian. Upon arrival, officers immediately located the pedestrian and, with a citizen's assistance, began life-saving measures that included CPR. The pedestrian, a 57-year-old female, was later treated by Torrance Fire Department personnel and transported to a local hospital with serious injuries.

The preliminary investigation reveals the driver of a 1990 Honda Civic was traveling east on Torrance Boulevard. While traveling east on Torrance Boulevard, the Honda Civic struck a pedestrian crossing southbound across Torrance Boulevard outside of a crosswalk. Investigators will conduct an extensive investigation to determine the details of this incident.

The driver of the 1990 Honda was not injured, and alcohol or drugs do not appear to be a factor in this collision.

All Eastbound lanes of Torrance Boulevard from Hawthorne Boulevard will be temporarily closed during this investigation.
