

## RESOLUTION NO. 2022-90

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2022-26 IMPLEMENTING GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 20636 (c)(4) PURSUANT TO SECTION 20691 RELATING TO EMPLOYER PAID MEMBER CONTRIBUTIONS TO PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM (CALPERS) FOR TORRANCE POLICE COMMANDERS ASSOCIATION (TPCA) EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2012

#### AMENDMENT #1

The City Council of the City of Torrance does hereby resolve as follows:

Resolution 2022-26 is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the governing body of the City of Torrance has the authority to implement Government Code Section 20636(c)(4) pursuant to Section 20691; and

**WHEREAS**, the governing body of the City of Torrance has a written labor policy or agreement which specifically provides for the normal member contributions to California Public Employees Retirement System (CalPERS) to be paid by the employer, and reported as additional compensation; and

**WHEREAS**, one of the steps in the procedures to implement Section 20691 is the adoption by the governing body of the City of Torrance of a Resolution to commence paying and reporting the value of said Employer Paid Member Contributions; and

**WHEREAS**, the governing body of the City of Torrance has identified the following conditions for the purpose of its election to pay EPMC:

- This benefit shall apply to all employees of Torrance Police Commanders Association (TPCA) hired prior to January 1, 2012.
- The City shall pay the employee's 9% contribution to PERS for safety employees of TPCA and will report the same percent (9%) of compensation earnable\* (excluding Government Code Section 20636(c)(4) as additional compensation) pursuant to California Government Code § 20691.
- The nine percent (9%) paid by the City shall be considered as employer-paid member contribution (EPMC) in accordance with Government Code § 20-023 20636(c)(4).
- Safety employees hired on or after January 1, 2012 shall pay their own employee contribution.
- The effective date of this Resolution shall be January 1, 2012.


\*Note: Payment of EPMC and reporting the value of EPMC on compensation earnable is on pay rate and special compensation except special compensation delineated in Government Code Section 20636(c)(4) which is the monetary value of EPMC on compensation earnable.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE HEREBY elects to pay and report the value of EPMC, as set forth above.
