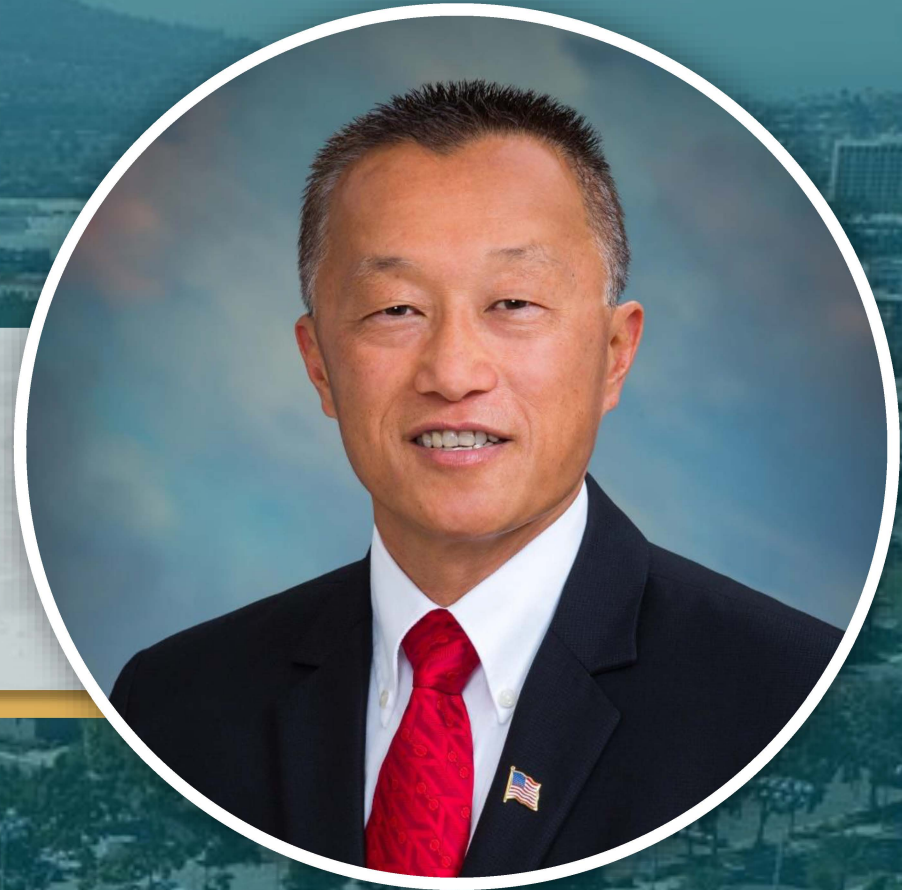
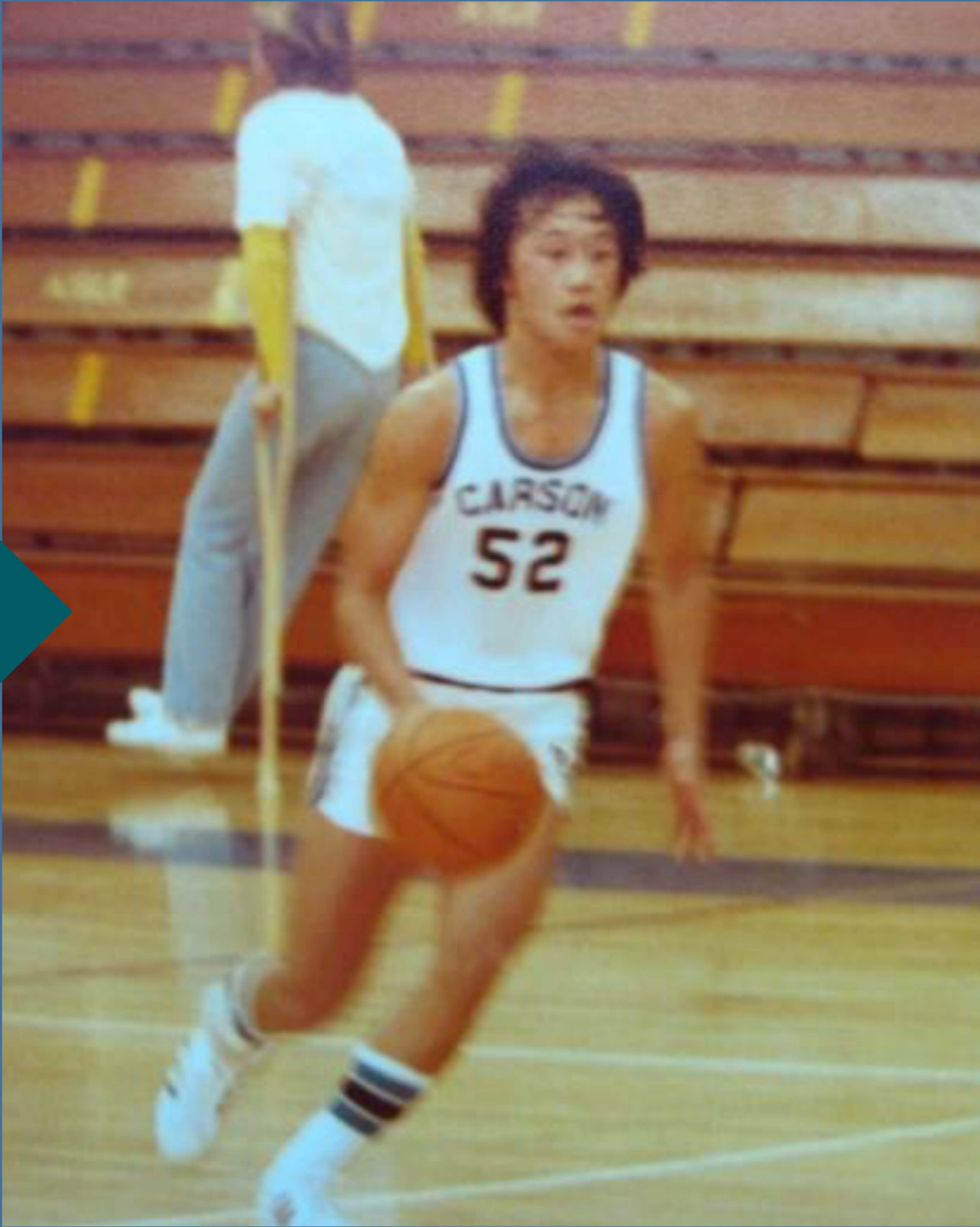

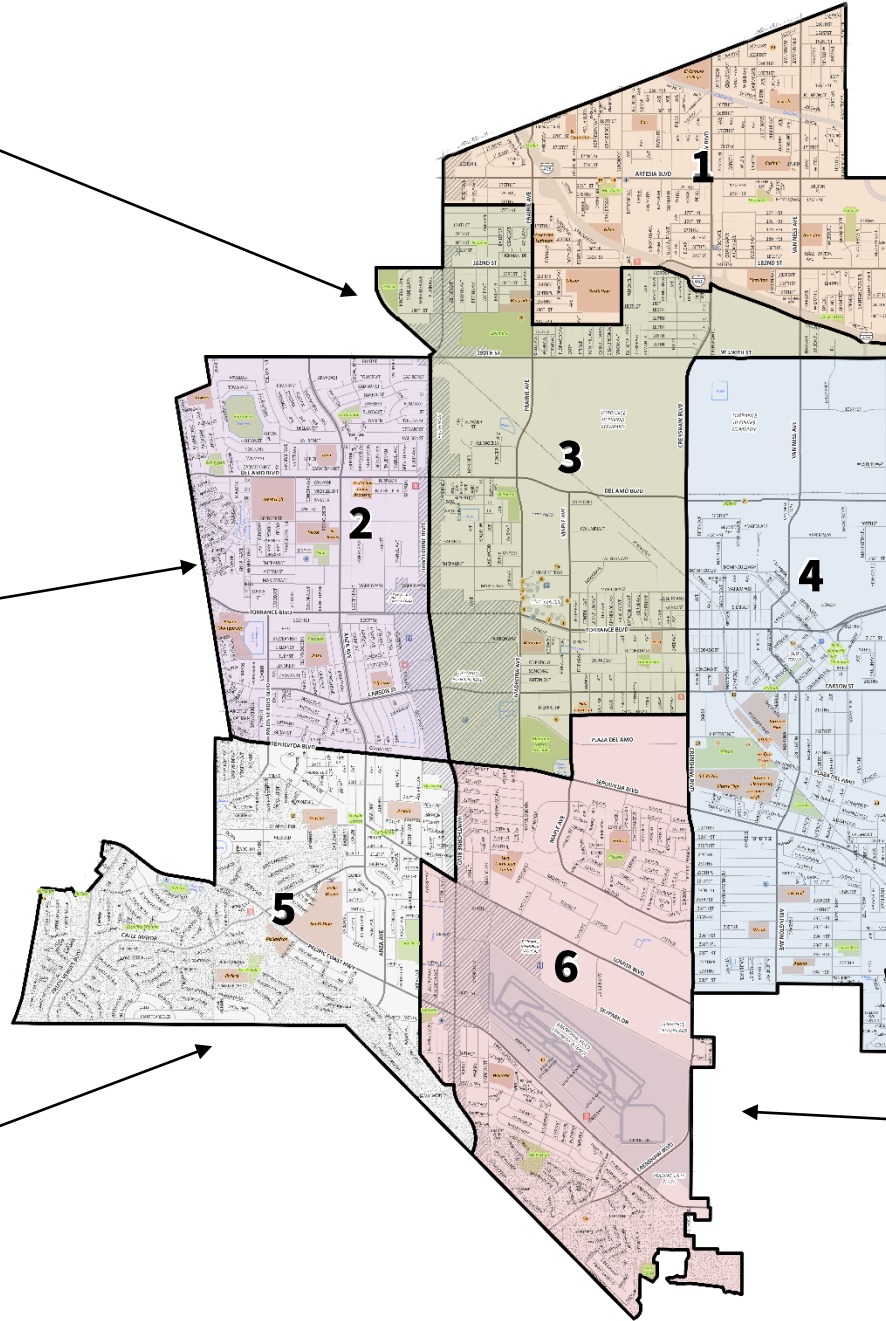

Mary began her career with the City of Torrance on May 18, 1987 as the Finance Director. She came with an extensive financial background, having previously served as Controller for the City of Long Beach and Audit Manager for Price Waterhouse. She became an expert in the City's financial processes and conducted numerous audits on citywide systems that led to improvements in internal controls.

Mary was a gifted leader with a sincere desire to serve. She mentored numerous management staff over the past three decades, helping them to grow. Her professional and warm interactions with City staff and the public established strong working relationships with other cities and agencies. She served as a Board Member of the Salvation Army and the Torrance Memorial Medical Center.

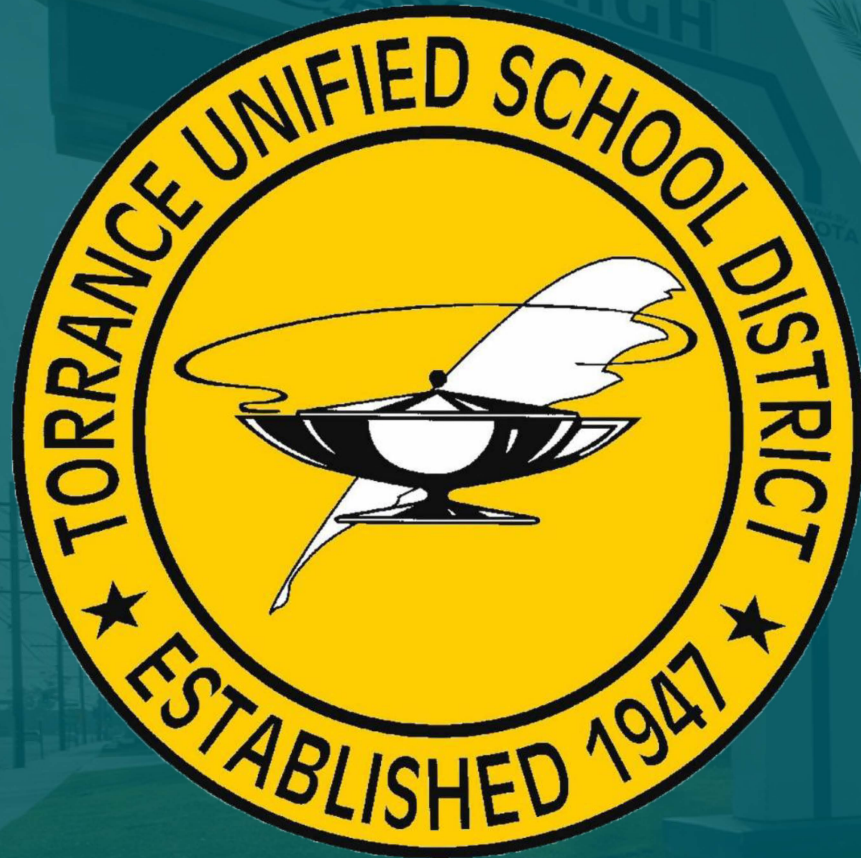

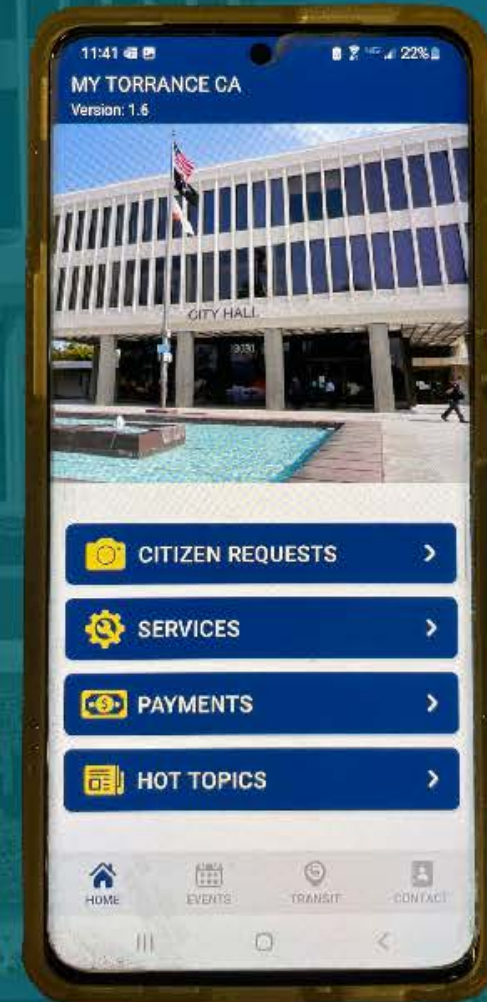
