

#### **Light Rail Profile**










## **Torrance Transit Center Station Area**







#### **Locally Preferred Alternative (LPA)**

Metro Board will vote to select an alignment and approve project to move forward



## **Project Acceleration (2028)**

- > **Timing**: requires reducing implementation schedule set by the Measure M expenditure plan (2030-2033) by 2 to 5 years
- > **Expedited Reviews, Approvals & Procurement**: requires streamlined reviews and approvals for final environmental clearance and permitting, engineering and final design, construction bids, and coordination with public and private entities (utilities, cities, railroads)
- > **Intensive Construction Period**: requires condensed construction period with day and night-time work and shortened testing period for operations
- > **Funding**: requires Metro to revisit the mix and timeline for funding as state and local sources for the Project are currently targeted towards the end of the 2020s
