Seven Individuals Cited During Bicycle, Pedestrian Safety Operation

The Torrance Police Department issued seven citations for a variety of violations made by drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclist during bicycle and pedestrian safety operations on September 27th and 28th.

Seven individuals were cited for violations including; 21456(B) CVC - Pedestrian Crossing against a Don't Walk Signal, 23123.5(a) B&P - Pedestrian with an open container of an alcoholic beverage, 23123(a) CVC & 23123.5(a) CVC - Cell Phone violations, 14601.1(a) CVC – Driving on a suspended license, and miscellaneous equipment violations.

The operations took place throughout the City of Torrance from 3:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. A total of nine people were contacted during the operation.

“Safety is a shared responsibility, with drivers holding the greatest responsibility to keep other road users safe,” Torrance Police Department Sergeant David Koenig said. “We hope this operation serves as a reminder to everyone to practice due care and to look out for one another.”

The Torrance Police Department will be holding another bicycle and pedestrian safety operation in the near future.
