PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Public is invited to review the City of Torrance 2022-2023 Homelessness Assistance and Supportive Service activity using HOME-AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN (HOME-ARP) funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

The City of Torrance's total HOME-ARP allocation is \$1,710,939. The range of activities the funding can be used for are: Tenant-Based Rental Assistance (TBRA), Development and Support of Affordable Housing, Provision of Supportive Services, Acquisition and Development of Non-Congregate Shelter (NCS) Units, Nonprofit Operating and Capacity Building Assistance, and Administration and Planning. The Torrance City Council approved the HOME-ARP Allocation Plan for supportive services on April 12, 2022.

The City of Torrance will be utilizing the funding for McKinney Vento Supportive Service Activities, including the Salary and Benefit package of an Outreach Coordinator employed by the City of Torrance.

Households in the following populations are eligible for assistance. Homeless; At Risk of Homelessness; Fleeing, or Attempting to Flee, Domestic Violence, Dating Violence, Sexual Assault, Stalking, or Human Trafficking; Other Families Requiring Services or Housing Assistance to Prevent Homelessness; Other Populations At Greatest Risk of Housing Instability; Veterans and Families that include a Veteran Family Member that meet the criteria for one of the qualifying populations. Torrance has instituted a preference for people experiencing homelessness.

If you are a Torrance resident, meet one of the qualifying populations, and are in need of supportive services, please contact 310-803-3390.
