BACKGROUND

PW-Sanitation Division provides wastewater collection citywide

- 36,000 accounts
- 287 miles of sewer pipelines
- 9 sewer lift stations
- Customer rates established by Cost of Service Study
- Last Cost of Service Study 2017-2021
- Last rate increase January 2021

OBJECTIVES

Determine new 5-year rates to provide adequate funding for:

- Operations and Maintenance
- Capital Improvement Program
- Reserves
- Covers 5-year period CY 2023-2027
- Cost of service based rates required by Proposition 218

COST OF SERVICE (COS)


- Based on recognized COS methodology consistent with Proposition 218
- Revenue requirements based on wastewater flow
- Customers:
 - Single Family Residential (SFR)
 - Other Customers (Multifamily/Commercial/Industrial)

FINDINGS

 Current rates are not adequate to meet operating, capital and reserve needs



CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS




PROJECTED OPERATING RESERVE FUND BALANCE






Reserve Balance without Rate Increase —Reserve Balance with Increase

OTHER CUSTOMER IMPACTS (Multifamily/Comm./Industrial)




