One Driver Arrested for DUI

The Torrance Police Department arrested one driver on suspicion of DUI on December 4th, 2022 and a passenger in the same vehicle was arrested for being intoxicated.



"We are committed to taking impaired drivers off the road," Sergeant David Koenig said. "Driving under the influence is not only dangerous, but also has major consequences."

Drivers charged with a first-time DUI face an average of \$13,500 in fines and penalties, as well as a suspended license.

The Torrance Police Department will be holding a series of DUI enforcement patrols throughout the year to keep our roadways safe.
