Applications are now being accepted for membership in the Torrance Youth Council. Interested teens should fill out the application and mail to:

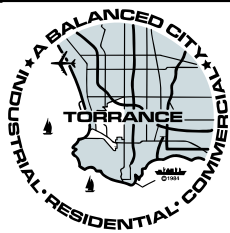
