Twelve Cited at Torrance DUI Checkpoint

December 18th, 2023

Twelve citations were issued to driver's for driving on a suspended/revoked license, or for driving while being unlicensed at a DUI/Driver's License Checkpoint on December 14th, where 818 vehicles were contacted.

The DUI checkpoint was held in the eastbound lanes of the 3400 block of Torrance Blvd. between 6:00 p.m. and 3:00 a.m.

DUI checkpoint locations are determined based on reported incidents of impaired driving-related crashes. The primary purpose of DUI checkpoints are to promote public safety by taking suspected impaired drivers off roads.
