High Visibility Enforcement Operation

On Thursday, April 11, 2024, between 7:30 AM and 11:30 AM, the Torrance Police Department will be conducting a citywide High Visibility Enforcment Operation due to recent public concerns. Officers will be focusing on vehicle code violations associated with e-bikes and other traffic violations.

The Torrance Police Department is committed to enhancing safe driving for both riders of e-bikes and drivers through high visibility enforcement and education in an effort to decrease traffic collisions, reduce injuries, and save lives. These operations utilize Traffic Sign Boards to remind bicyclist and drivers to obey all traffic laws. As legislation begins to catch up with this evolving technology, many riders are unaware of the laws associated with e-bikes and our goal is to educate them and make them safer riders. Motor Officers will devote the majority of their time educating e-bike riders and commuters around our schools.
