Fatal Traffic Collision Incident #240012708

April 12th, 2024

On April 12, 2024, at approximately 1:24 am, officers from the Torrance Police Department responded to a major injury traffic collision involving a motorcyclist in the 25200 block of Crenshaw Boulevard.

On arrival, officers discovered a solo vehicle collision involving a black 2021, Harley Davidson motorcycle. The initial investigation indicates the motorcyclist was traveling southbound on Crenshaw Boulevard when the rider lost control for an unknown reason while negotiating a curve in the roadway and collided with the center median.

The rider and sole occupant of the Harley Davidson, a 28-year-old male resident of Gardena was treated by Torrance Fire Department personnel at the scene, but he unfortunately succumbed to his injuries. The deceased has been positively identified by investigators, but his name is being withheld pending notification of next of kin.

Both directions of Crenshaw Boulevard between Skypark Drive and Airport Drive were closed for approximately 6 hours during the course of the investigation.

This collision is being investigated by the Torrance Police Department's Traffic Division under the command of Captain James Titiriga, Commander of the Special Operations Bureau.
