Vehicle Inspection Fees

Upon receipt of your payment and vehicle information, the submitted forms will be forwarded to the Torrance Police Department, Traffic Division. Inspections will be conducted at the Torrance City Yard by appointment only. Please call (310) 618-5557 between the hours of 7:30 am and 4:00 pm to schedule an appointment. Refer to the attached requirements from the Police Department to pass the vehicle inspection and be provided with a sticker to be placed in a visible location at the rear of the vehicle.

Inspection Fees:

- 1st Inspection: \$50.00 per vehicle (are required to be paid with license fees)
- 2nd Inspection: \$50.00 per vehicle (if necessary)
- 3rd or subsequent inspections: \$67.00 per vehicle (if necessary)

Additional Information:

All vehicles involved in the conducting of a regulated business in the City of Torrance are required to be inspected and licensed. This includes small Jeep (or similar type) pickups that may be used to facilitate pickup/or delivery of commercial dumpsters.

Important Notice

When filling out the vehicle listing.
LIST ONLY the vehicles operating in the City of Torrance

Until each vehicle has passed inspection the business **will not** be licensed to operate in the City of Torrance and will be subject to issuance of a **CITATION** if found to be operating within the city limits.

Vehicles can easily be **added** at any time during the year.

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Vehicle Inspection Requirements for City Licensing
Waste Haulers & Recycling /Scrap/Hazardous Material Dealers
Salvage/Junk Collectors
Lunch & Ice Cream Trucks

In the current calendar year, as in the past, the City of Torrance will be conducting vehicle inspections which must be successfully completed in order for your company to carry on business within the City. Inspections are done **by appointment only** and can be scheduled by calling the Torrance Police Department, Traffic Division at 310-618-5557 during regular business hours.

It would be in your best interest to schedule your inspections as early in the year as possible. Be sure to prepare your vehicles for the inspection as additional fees will be charged for each follow-up inspection. All drivers are required to perform and demonstrate all safety functions of their vehicle (26508(o) CVC). Failure to do so could result in the failure of the Torrance Police Department inspection.

The following list of items to be inspected has been outlined below to assist you:

1. Registration and Proof of Insurance: Current/Accurate
2. License Plates and Tabs: As required, current and properly mounted
3. Lighting Equipment: Required lighting must be in proper working condition
4. Windshield: Free of defects
5. Windshield wipers: Serviceable condition and functioning
6. Mirrors: Two required, properly mounted and free from defects
7. Trademarks: Contrasting color, legible on both sides as required by code
8. Horn: Audible/Functioning
9. Reflectors: As required (24607, 24608 CVC)
10. Tires: Free from defects, adequate tread depth, matching
11. Rims: Free from cracks, all lugs nuts secure (none missing)
12. Mud guards: proper coverage (length and width)
13. Exhaust: gas tight, adequately muffled and filtered
14. Fuel cap: properly fitted, non-combustible
15. Steering system: no excessive lash or wear
16. Brake System: must pass standardized inspection
17. Emergency Brake System: Operative, auto application
18. Roadside Warning Devices: Three, approved type (triangles or flares)
19. Frame/Suspension: tight fittings, free from cracks
20. Back-up alarm: must be audible from fifty feet away
21. Driver License: Proper classification and current Medical Card (if required)
22. Current LA County Health Permit (if required)
23. Fire Extinguisher: Proper class, securely and conspicuously mounted (if required)
24. State of California Motor Carrier Permit number obtained and displayed as required by the State. The permit can be obtained from the State Department of Motor Vehicles for further information please go to this link: <https://www.dmv.ca.gov/portal/vehicle-industry-services/motor-carrier-services-mcs/motor-carrier-permits/>

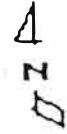

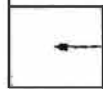
