SUBJECT: Accept and File Adopted Fiscal Year 2024-25 Measure SST Fund Budget Report.

#### RECOMMENDATION

Recommendation of the Finance Director that the Measure SST Citizens' Oversight Committee accept and file the adopted Measure SST Fund Budget Report for fiscal year 2024-25.

#### BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

On June 4, 2024, City Council formally adopted the City's Proposed Fiscal Year 2024-25 Operating Budget and Capital Improvement Plan, which included the Measure SST Fund. The Measure SST Fund comprises approximately 8.6% of the General Fund's overall expenditure budget. This fund separately accounts for the 0.50% transaction and use tax (sales tax) approved by the Torrance voters in June 2022.

#### Operating Budget

As shown in the table below, the Measure SST Fund's FY24-25 revenue budget will increase by \$2.1 million (+9.3%) and the expenditure budget will increase by \$4.5 million (+19.4%).

The Measure SST Fund's operating expenditure budget of \$27,495,124 is broken down into four (4) main categories: Quality of Life; Fiscal Sustainability; Deferred Maintenance and Community Services/Programs; and Emergency Responsiveness. The following table provides a summary of the Measure SST Fund's fiscal year 2024-25 (FY24-25) operating budget allocations for each of these categories.

The 'Restore/Maintain Public Safety' sub-category includes specified amounts committed to supporting the Police and Fire Departments. Additionally, 'Cyber Security Upgrades' has devoted funding for a 1.0 full-time equivalent Systems Analyst position dedicated to cybersecurity efforts in the Communications and Information Technology (CIT) Department, with the remainder going towards non-wage expenditures as approved by City Council.

The position offsets in the Police, Fire and CIT Departments are represented under the 'Other Operating Transfers Out' expenditure classification. The table below provides the line item details for each department's respective position offset as well as transfers to the General Fund's Unassigned Fund, Restricted/Assigned Fund, and Capital Project Funds.

### Capital Budget

The 'Capital Contribution' sub-category includes 16 projects funded by transaction and use tax (sales tax) revenues from Measure SST to benefit and invest in the Torrance community at-large. The adopted FY24-25 Capital Improvement Plan budget commits \$7.8 million from the Measure SST Fund for investments in the City's parks, libraries, community facilities, police and fire stations, and the planting of 7,000 trees citywide. As shown in the

table below, the City plans to invest a total of \$25.8 million from the Measure SST Fund over the next four years.
