SUBJECT: Accept and File Fiscal Year 2023-24 Measure SST Fund Annual Report.

RECOMMENDATION

Recommendation of the Finance Director that the Measure SST Citizens' Oversight Committee accept and file the Measure SST Fund Annual Report for fiscal year 2023-24.

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

On February 15, 2022, City Council adopted Resolution No. 2022-21 to submit for voter consideration a local half cent sales tax ballot measure to be spent exclusively for services benefitting City of Torrance (City) residents.

On June 7, 2022, Torrance voters approved Measure SST which included the appointment of a citizens' oversight committee, public disclosure of all spending and annual independent financial audits to ensure funds are used effectively as promised to the benefit of the Torrance community.

On July 12, 2022, City Council approved the creation of the Measure SST Fund, a sub-fund of the City's General Fund to separately track all revenues and expenditures in compliance with the annual independent financial audit provision outlined in the ballot measure.

On February 7, 2023, pursuant to Torrance Municipal Code Section 232.1.120, City Council adopted Resolution No. 2023-11 establishing guidelines for the composition and duties of the Measure SST Citizens' Oversight Committee (Committee).

The Committee is comprised of seven-members appointed by City Council with varying term assignments, which are also designated by City Council. The powers and duties of the Committee include:

- Review the Measure SST Fund annual operating budget adopted by City Council.
- Review semi-annual reports from City staff each fiscal year on revenues and expenditures of the Measure SST Fund.
- Review the annual third-party financial statement audit of the Measure SST Fund.
- Advise City Council on issues identified.
- Perform any other action or activity that may be directed by the City Council.
