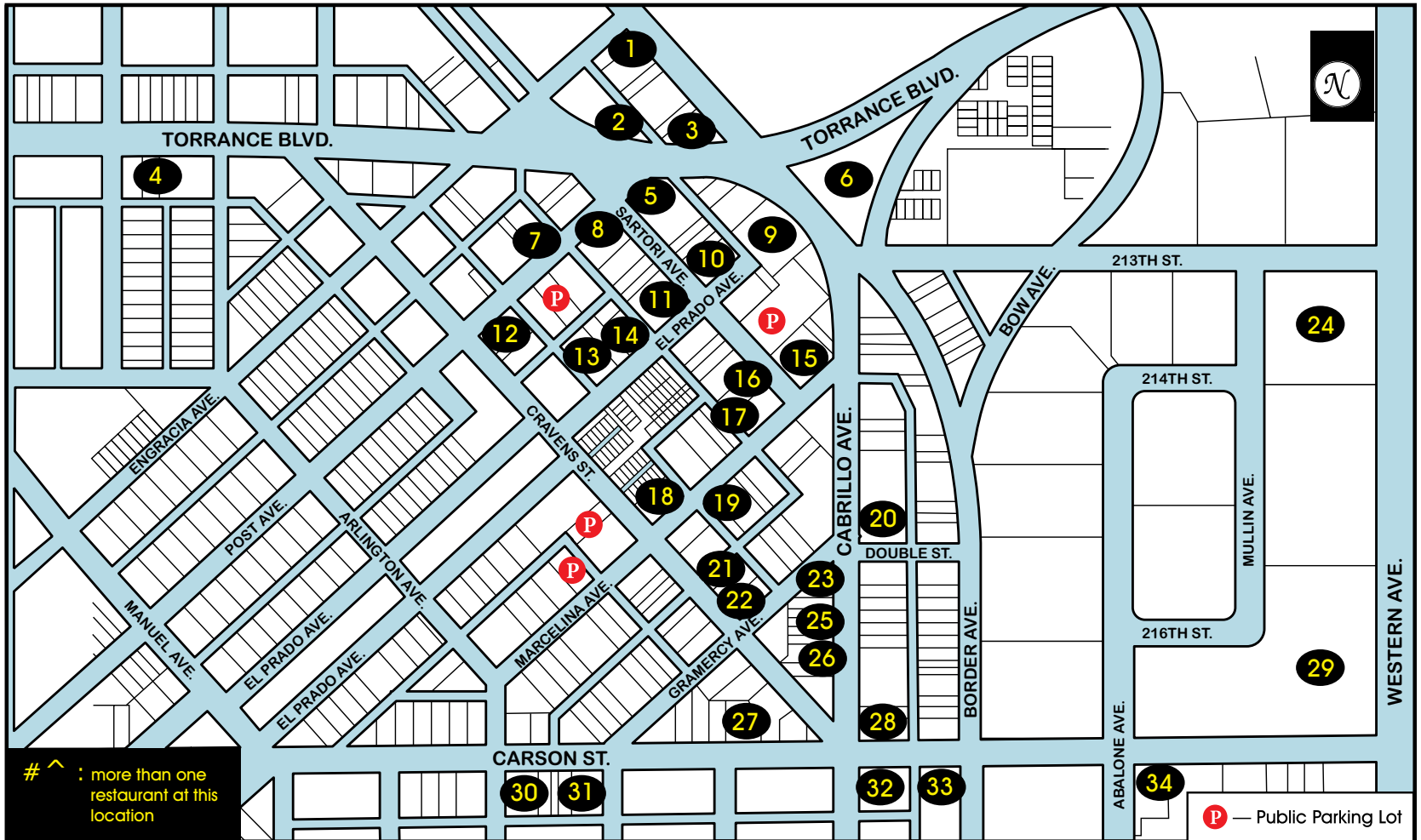

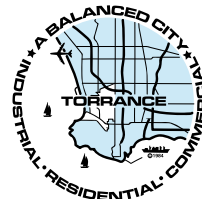
# Torrance 1912-
