  - Emphasize that we can effect change at the local level



- > There are two ways for students to submit essays.

- The Essay form will include spaces for the Student's Name, School, Parent Email, Home Phone Number, and Address, as well as parent contact information. NO HARD COPIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.
- > Essays will be judged on content.
- Up to 23 students comprised of 8<sup>th</sup> Graders from TUSD and private schools in Torrance will be selected to participate.
- Students may be selected to shadow the following positions: Mayor, City Councilmembers (6), City Treasurer, City Clerk, City Manager, Assistant City Manager, City Attorney, Communication & Information Technology Director, Community Development Director, Community Services Director, Finance Director, Fire Chief, General Services Director, Human Resources Director, Police Chief, Public Works Director, Transit Director.
